

SVD MIC Input/Output

This setup will allow you to record audio and play back on your monitor should your monitor support audio input.

For this guide you will need a Phono cable, Male at each end that you can cut.


You will also need the EXTEND cable that comes with the SVD420/820 unit.

- Cut the Phono cable in half, expose the bar ends, center cable being + and outer cable being - (GND).
- Connect one phono cable to each of the cables listed below; solder or secure the cable with electrical tape for testing.
- Connect the phono cable from Audio-In into the MIC.
- Connect the DC socket on the MIC to a power source (12v) or connect to the DC plug on the AV output cable of the SVD.
- Connect the phono cable from Audio-Out to your monitor if you have one.
- In the SVD Menu:
 - Menu
 - Record
 - Codec

Make sure Audio is ticked for the channels you wish to record, *Remember to click save and apply to all if you want audio recorded on all channels.


- You can now exit the menu, let the unit record for a few minutes and then play back, you will hear audio on your monitor.
